### **Pollinator Garden**

The Westgate Community Foundation is excited to share an update on a beautification project we've been working on this past year. A pollinator garden was identified as an asset that could benefit and enhance a highly visible Westgate entrance into the neighborhood. This project is supported by the Omaha Neighborhood Grants Program, a program of the Omaha Community Foundation. Over the course of the summer, planning and preparations were made. Once the summer heat started to subside, Foundation volunteers got to work on the berm north of the Westgate Pool on Grover street. You may have noticed the changes, and while it doesn't look like much and currently looks dead, the roots below are busy getting established. Patience will be the key and over the next few years, we will see our efforts come to life. As part of the overall beautification project, we will be incorporating public art pieces in the form of steel sculptures. We are in conversation with the Westside High School Welding, Fabrication and Manufacturing Lab to have students design and produce these sculptures. We are excited for the collaboration opportunity and ability to support our Westside School District.

### Pipal Park Masterplan

The Omaha Parks has identified Westgate's Pipal Park as one of their next upgrade projects. The Landscape Architects and Omaha Parks held an information meeting on October 7th to present their masterplan and receive public comment. Visit the Westgate Community Foundation website at:
